# International Swim meet "RIGA SKINS RACE" Regulations

## 1. Venue and Time

- 1.1. The competition will take place at the Ķīpsala Swimming Pool, located at Ķīpsalas Street 5, Riga (Latvia). The pool is a 50m, 8-lane pool with electronic competition management and automatic timing equipment (OMEGA Ares 21).
- 1.2. The competition dates are 28-29 March 2025.
- 1.3. Start time:
  - 1.3.1. March 28: 12:30 PM (warm-up starts 45 minutes before session);
  - 1.3.2. March 29: 13:15 PM (warm-up starts 45 minutes before session).

# 2. Competition Management and Conduct

- 2.1. The competition is organized by the Swimming Club "Riga" in collaboration with the Latvian Swimming Federation and financially supported by the Riga City Council's Education, Culture and Sports Department.
- 2.2. The competition will be conducted according to the World Aquatics swimming competition rules and regulations. The competition will be overseen by certified referees and starters.
- 2.3. In disciplines with a final swim, 2 reserve swimmers are announced/published. They must report to the registration area before the respective event. In the 50m freestyle elimination rounds, the following number of reserves is determined:

For the TOP 64 round - 6 reserves;

For the TOP 32 round - 4 reserves;

For the TOP 16 round – 2 reserves.

- 2.4. A team representative can withdraw a swimmer from the final, elimination rounds, or reserve list within 10 minutes after the announcement or publication of the preliminary heat results by sending a message to phone number +371 28386080.
- 2.5. In case of a protest, it must be submitted to the competition referee in writing within 20 minutes after the end of the respective event. Protests can be submitted by the management of the participating sports school/club or an authorized team representative. The deposit for filing a protest is 50.00 EUR.

# 3. Participants

- 3.1. The competition is open to any interested parties from Latvia and other European Union member states as well as for other invited international clubs and nations.
- 3.2. The first day's events are for the following age groups:
  - 3.2.1. Group I Born in 2014 and younger;
  - 3.2.2. Group II Born in 2011-2013;
  - 3.2.3. Group III Born in 2008-2010;
  - 3.2.4. Open Group (no age limits).

# 4. Entry Fee

- 4.1. For foreign athletes: 12.00 EUR per event entered.
- 4.2. A 100% discount is applied to entries with a result equal to 850 WA points or higher (WA 2025 table).
- 4.3. The entry fee must be paid electronically as per the invoice details sent.

#### 6. Scoring and Awards

6.1. In each discipline (including the 200m medley and 50m freestyle), the winners in Age Groups I-III are determined based on a single-start principle. The 1st–3rd place winners are awarded medals and special prizes from cooperation partners.

In the Open group disciplines, athletes are awarded only in the 200m medley final according to regulation point 6.2.1 and in the 50m freestyle Skins Race format rounds according to regulation point 6.2.2.

Prizes are not awarded if the athlete has not completed the distance in accordance with the competition rules.

6.2. In the Open disciplines (final of the 200m medley and 50m freestyle Skins Race), athletes compete in a single age group, and the winners are awarded the following cash prizes:

# 7. Entries

- 7.1. Entries are accepted from the management of the swimmer's representing organization or institution (sports school, club, educational institution) or an authorized team representative, who confirms and assumes full responsibility for the health condition of the participants, their regular health checks, and their ability to participate in the competition.
- 7.2. Each team can enter an unlimited number of participants.
- 7.3. Entries must be submitted electronically via the online registration system: <u>https://www.swimrankings.net/manager/</u>.
- 7.4. A summary of the technical entry (in .pdf format from the online system) must be sent to the email: <u>klubs@pkriga.lv</u> by March 21 at 12:00 PM.
- 7.5. Additional entries, with a fee of 20.00 EUR per event, can be submitted within 48 hours after the deadline mentioned in point 7.4.
- 7.6. No changes are accepted after the invoice is prepared and sent.
- 7.7. Participation in the competition is guaranteed only after full payment of the invoice. If the invoice is not paid by the specified deadline, the team's entry is rejected.
- 7.8. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- 7.9. Cash payments are not accepted.

# 8. Personal Data Processing

- 8.1. The controller of personal data, including accreditation data, is the "Riga" Swimming Club (PK Riga).
- 8.2. The legal basis for data processing is the necessity to perform the tasks set out in normative acts, particularly the Sports Law and these regulations.
- 8.3. The purpose of data processing is to record, accredit, analyze activities and results, manage material values, and promote and reflect the competition in the media.
- 8.4. The event and its participants will be photographed and recorded on video, with publication rights (including live broadcasts, storage in a public archive, and reuse) transferred to PK Riga and its chosen partners.
- 8.5. Data on the number of participants, regional and educational institution affiliation, and sporting achievements will be published both aggregated and detailed.
- 8.6. PK Riga staff and its partners will receive the data to the extent necessary to perform their duties.
- 8.7. Personal data will be stored according to the regulations until the end of the specified term.
- 8.8. Involved persons have the right to request access to, correct, or delete their data, object to data processing (if necessary for participation in the competition), transfer their data, and file complaints with the Data State Inspectorate if they believe their data is being processed unlawfully.
