- Venue – Lazdynai swimming pool (10 lanes, 25 m), Erfurto street 13, Vilnius.
- Competition results will be recorded using the SWISS TIMING electronic system.
- Lithuanian and international athletes are welcome to participate in the competition, except for Russian and Belarusian athletes who do not have permission to reside in the EU.
- The competition will follow the "World Aquatics" rules.
- All events will be held as timed finals.
- Entries may be submitted in two ways:
 - Regular Entries: **Deadline is 23:59 on 29 November 2024. The participation fee is €30 for up to 4 starts.**
 - Late Entries: Accepted from 00:00 on 30 November 2024 until 12:00 on 6 December 2024. During this period, each start incurs a fee of €15.
- Changes and withdrawals will be accepted until 15:00 on 6 December 2024 via email at info@vilniuswimcup.lt. No changes or withdrawals will be accepted after this deadline.
- Participants must have medical clearance permitting them to compete. Team leaders are responsible for ensuring all required approvals are valid.



8. When submitting technical applications, teams must make final decisions regarding the number and selection of events each participant will compete in, as no changes will be allowed afterward.

9. The sending organization must transfer payment for each participant's entry. All team and club details, including billing information, competition entries, and accommodation arrangements, must be specified and paid by 6 December 2024.

10. The fine for failing to meet the standards in the 200 m freestyle and 200 m medley events is €20.

13. After the starting protocols are published on 19 January at 12:00, no changes will be accepted, and fees for participants and other services will not be refunded.

14. If the entry fees are not paid by the end of the competition, an additional fee of 20% of the total amount will be charged.

15. If the number of participants falls below 300 or exceeds 800, the organizer reserves the right to modify the competition format. The maximum number of participants is 1,000.

16. During the race, the pool's internal rules will be enforced.

17. The sending organization is responsible for the health of its participants. The organizer is not liable for any injuries sustained by athletes, health deterioration, or theft.

18. All expenses, including lodging and travel, must be covered by the sending organization or the participants themselves.

***Note:** Athletes of all ages participate together in the 200m distances in the "Open Class" group, and only the top three athletes (girls and boys) will be awarded.

20. Winners of each race and each group who placed 1st will receive medals and prizes, while the winners of 2nd and 3rd places will receive medals (and prizes if available).

21. A participant who does not attend the award ceremony may forfeit their right to receive a prize.

22. The Vilnius Swim Cup is a public event that may be filmed and photographed.

23. Participants agree that the filmed or photographed material will be distributed in the media or online.

24. Team leaders are responsible for: adhering to deadlines; ensuring the participants' safety during arrival, departure, and the competition; and maintaining proper behavior of their athletes during the competition and free time.

25. By submitting an entry, the team confirms that they have read and will comply with these regulations.

26. The organizers reserve the right to change the date, time, or schedule of the event if necessary.
