3. IDENTIFICATION

All swimmers must show their accreditation card to the referee before competing. Without this card, the swimmer will not be allowed to compete. NO EXCEPTIONS.

4. COMPETITION INFORMATION

- Swimmers may compete in 4 events and 2 relays.
- There will be the following competitions: 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m Freestyle
 50m, 100m, 200m Backstroke
 50m, 100m, 200m Breaststroke
 50m, 100m, 200m Butterfly
 200m Individual Medley
 4 x100m Freestyle Relay
 4 x100m Medley Relay
 4x100m Mixed Medley Relay (2 Boys and 2 Girls)
- Each city may enter a maximum of 4 boys and 4 girls and a minimum of 4 swimmers.
- Cities can enter a maximum of 2 swimmers per event.
- Swimmers must supply personal best performance times for each event during registration process for a proper seed of heats and lanes. It is the responsibility of cities also, to provide times for the relay events for the same purposes.
- The pool is an indoor 50m 8 lanes facility & warm-ups will be arranged each day, before the heats and finals begin.

- Electronic timing and lane display scoreboard will be in use.
- One coach per city is allowed.

5. COMPETITION RULES

- The meet will take place according to World Aquatics and ICG rules.
- Racing suits are required for all competitors. Swimwear must comply with current World Aquatics regulation.
- During warm-up no dives or jumps are allowed unless in designated lanes opened up by the officials or meet director.
- Athletes will be provided with full pool access for warm up at least 30 minutes prior to the first race commencing.
- All events will have one final only.
- **There will be no B Finals.** (this Technical Commission decision was based on feedback from cities and coaches, that the swim programme was too long as it stood.)

6. TRAINING SCHEDULE

- Training times will be available at the sport facility on August 4th, 2025.
- Training schedule will be posted on the website.
- The World Aquatics website <u>www.worldaquatics.com</u> provides a copy of the latest WA Constitution, Laws and Regulations for competition.

7. TECHNICAL MEETING

- A Technical meeting for all coaches will be held on August 4th, 2025.

- Any disputes will be resolved in accordance with World Aquatics rules and the clauses included in the ICG Rules.
- Any official Protest will be referred to the Protest Committee according to the ICG Rules.

10. DISCIPLINARY RULES

- The ICG Code of Conduct must be adhered to at all times
- Heads of Delegation, athletes and coaches will be excluded from the Games for indecent behaviour, abusive language etc.
- All delegations have to comply with any instruction given by the venue staff.
- Coaches are responsible for the well-being and behaviour of their athletes at all times.

11.PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

Individual Competitions:

GOLD – for swimmers ranking 1st SILVER – for swimmers ranking 2nd BRONZE – for swimmers ranking 3rd **Team competitions:** GOLD – for team ranking 1st SILVER – for team ranking 2nd BRONZE – for team ranking 3rd

- Swimmers must wear their team uniform or tracksuit for the ceremony
- No flags of any type, city or country, will be allowed to be on display at the Medal Ceremony.
- No medals will be awarded to coaches.
- Medal presentations will be made at the designated times as per the schedule.
- Coaches are requested to assist in ensuring swimmers are readily available and correctly dressed for the medal presentation.

12. MEDICAL

A first aid service will be available on site A full Medical Service will be available at one of the hospitals in Tallinn.
