Heats will be arranged based on submitted entry times, with the fastest

swimmers first.

Distances and formats:

50 m: Heats and finals (16 fastest advance to the finals).

100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 800 m: Direct finals. 400 m: Maximum 16 swimmers per gender. 800 m: Maximum 8 swimmers per gender.

Swimming Pool: Pool: Indoor 50 m pool, 8 lanes. Depth at start end: 1.85 m. Water

temperature: 27.5°C.

Timing: Timing will be conducted using the OMEGA QUANTUM electronic timing

system.
