1. Lazdynai swimming pool address: Erfurto st. 13, Vilnius.
2. Times will be recorded with SWISS TIMING electronics 10 lanes, 50 m swimming pool.
3. Lithuanian and foreign athletes are welcomed to participate in the competition (except for Russian and Belarussian athletes who have no permission to resident in Lithuania).
4. World Aquatics rules will be applied.

5. Valid one start rule.
 - Entries must be submitted by two options:
 - no later than 17:00 h, 23-01-2026. The start fee would be - 30.00 (Thirty EUR 00 ct).
 - max 4 starts
 - -after 17.00 h 23-01-2026 until 12.00 h 30-01-2026 all application reads "late entries" for all participants. On these dates, the fee for each start would be 15.00 (Fifteen EUR 00 ct).
6. Changes / withdrawals will be accepted until 12:00 h 30-01-2026. By email: info@vilniusswimcup.lt . After this date, no changes/deletes will be accepted..
7. Entries must hold doctors' visas allowing participation in competition. Team leaders are responsible for the valid allowances
8. When submitting technical applications, the teams must finally decide how many and which events a certain participant will swim, as it will not be possible to change them later.
9. The sending organization must transfer money for each participant start. All team club data, billing information, competitions, accommodation, specified and payable by 31 th of January 2026.
10. The fine for failure to comply with the standard in the distances of 200 m freestyle/200 m medley is 15 Euro.
 - 200 m freestyle standards: 2.45.00 min. for boys and 3.00.00 for girls.
 - 200 m medley standards: 3.00.00 min. for boys and 3.15.00 for girls.
11. If you need an invoice, please contact: info@vilniusswimcup.lt.
12. If the entry fees are not paid before the end of the competition weekend, or 5 days after sending the invoice, an additional fee of 20% of the amount will be charged.
13. The number of participants on a non 350 (three hundred), or in excess of 800 (eight hundred), the organizer reserves the right to change the competition format. Maximum participant number is 800.
14. During the race, the pools internal rules of procedure are valid.
15. The sending organization is responsible for its participants health. Organizer is not responsible for injuries incurred by athletes, health deterioration, theft.
16. All expenses (lodging, travel) must be paid by the sending organization or the participants themselves.
17. Participants age groups:
 - I age group: Girls and Boys born in 2012.**
 - II age group: Girls and Boys born in 2013.**
 - III age group: Girls and Boys born in 2014.**
 - IV age group: Girls and Boys born in 2015.**
 - V age group: Girls and Boys born in 2016.**
 - VI age group: Girls and Boys born in 2017 and younger.**

VII age group: Girls and Boys born in 20011 and older.

* Note: Athletes of all ages take part in the 200m distances in the „Open Class“ group, and just 3 best's athletes (girls/boys) will be awarded.

18. Award ceremony: the winners of each race, group in the 1st place will be awarded with medals and prizes, and winners of II and III places with medals (prizes if possible).
19. The participant who does not attend the award ceremony may lose the right to a prize.
20. The Vilnius swim cup is a public event, where videos and photos might be taken.
21. The filmed and photographed material may be published in the media and online.
22. The team leaders are responsible for: following the deadlines; the participants' safety during the arrival/departure and the competition; proper behaviour of their athletes during the competition and the free time.
23. When submitting an application form participants agree to the Terms and Conditions of the Event.
23. The team, upon submitting the application, confirms that they have met and agreed to these regulations
24. Organizers reserve the right to change the date, time, or program of the event, if necessary.
